PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY.

We look forward to seeing you and your family at the Kansas State Fair 4-H Horse Show! We have 70 exhibitors this year. The following information should help you navigate your visit.

4-H Horses can enter the Kansas State Fairgrounds for stalling, vet check and show check-in from 12-3pm and 5-7pm on Wednesday, September 11. Wednesday show check-in will take place in Expo II. The show will begin at 9am Thursday, September 12. Expo I will not be available for exhibitors to ride in Wednesday. Please be respectful of the Kansas State Fair and do not attempt to enter the arena with your horses.

Required Health Papers

• A negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) test is required to have been conducted within one year of the show.

Check-in at Fairgrounds – GATE 10

• Gate 10, located on South Plum is where all horses must enter Fairgrounds.

• Gate personnel will direct exhibitors to the Stall office for further

instructions and assignments. You MUST stop at the stalling office to receive your stalls and your credentials.

• Coggins will be checked at stalls. Stalling office will notify vets for inspection.

<u>Check-in for 4-H Show Table inside Expo II (Wednesday) and Expo I</u> (Thursday, Friday, Saturday)

• EXHIBITORS **MUST** PRESENT THEIR HORSE WITH THEIR ORIGINAL 4-H HORSE ID PAPER OR REGISTRATION PAPER (whichever you used to ID your horse in your county) prior to checking in for the show. EXHIBITORS THAT DO NOT HAVE THEIR APPROPRIATE ID WILL NOT BE CHECKED IN OR ALLOWED TO SHOW.

•Show check-in table Wednesday will be located near the large overhead door on the west side of Expo II. Check in is available from 12-3pm and 5-7pm.

•Show check-in table located next to the announcer's stand – Bring horse and 4-H Horse ID(s). Please remove all blankets/covers before presenting horses. ID's must be the original ID. No copies will be accepted. Clerks will double check classes, horse(s), and horse identification papers. No adding classes or substituting horses. If showing a three-year old have information available (if entered in those classes).

• Exhibitors will receive packet that includes show program, number and tshirt if pre-ordered during the family's horse entry registration process.

Show Day

• Check-in with the gate person prior to each class. It is the 4-H member's responsibility to be at the gate and ready for the class.

• Additional show programs available for a fee.
