Time limit: 4 minutes per 6 arrow end

Juniors: 4-H age 9-13 12 arrows at 30 meters; 12 arrows at 20 meters

Seniors: 4-H age 14-18 12 arrows at 40 meters; 12 arrows at 30 meters

Minimum qualifying scores:

Recurve Barebow	120 points
Recurve Olympic	140 points
Compound- Bow Hunter	200 points
Compound - Open	210 points

Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters each class.
